SECURITY ALERT- PACKAGES LEFT AT THE DOOR STOLEN: Please be aware there are thieves stealing packages from doorsteps and porches. This week on the 1500 block of Reeves, video footage shows a Caucasian male with tattoos running up to the door and taking two packages. ACS security patrols the neighborhood 24 hours a day, looking for suspicious characters. Below are a few added suggestions for security in Beverlywood:

1. **DELIVER WHEN HOME OR TO A NEIGHBOR:** Have packages delivered when someone is home or to a neighbor who can receive packages on your behalf.
2. **AMAZON LOCKBOX:** If the package is from Amazon, Amazon has a lock box at 7-11 on Airdrome and Robertson (1665 Airdrome) and packages can be delivered there on your behalf. For more information:

3. **REPORT, INFORM AND FILE:** If something is stolen, **REPORT** the crime to **ACS** and the **POLICE**, **INFORM BHA** and **FILE A POLICE REPORT**. Filing will help track crime in the neighborhood and alerts the police department of issues in the area.

CIRCLE PARK TREES ARE NOT FOR CLIMBING: Tree climbing in Circle Park is prohibited and dangerous. We encourage homeowners to enjoy the shade and beauty of the trees, but keep their feet on the ground.

MAINTAINED LANDSCAPE IS SAFER LANDSCAPING: We have many homeowners who walk, jog or exercise in the neighborhood. Please be cognizant to keep your plantings trimmed back from the sidewalk and your branches from hanging too low from the trees. Plantings on the sidewalk can be a hazard.

An informed neighbor is usually a more tolerant and happy neighbor.

BARBECUE SAFETY: Summer is always a fun time to barbecue, but it is also important to be safe. Please make sure to barbecue in a well-ventilated area away from buildings, overhead combustible surface, dry leaves or plantings. Safety procedures can prevent accidental fires.
