- **WHAT TO DO IF YOU IN EVENT OF A CRIME:** If you witness or are a victim of a crime, **REPORT** the crime to **ACS** and the **POLICE, INFORM BHA** and **FILE A POLICE REPORT**.
 - **REPORT AND INFORM:** Reporting the crime helps keep you and your neighbors potentially safer. ACS will be more aware in patrolling the neighborhood. BHA can alert the neighbors, and both ACS and LAPD may be able to identify crime patterns that could potentially help catch the perpetrators. The police may allocate more crime fighting resources based on the reported data. Here are some **IMPORTANT PHONE NUMBERS:**

 - **FILING A POLICE REPORT:** If you have been a victim of a crime, reporting a crime to LAPD can be very difficult, but it can make a difference in preventing future crime. **Here are some ways to report crimes to LAPD:**
 1. Call 911 (Only For Life Threatening Emergencies Only)
 2. Call **1-877-ASK-LAPD** (Non- Life Threatening Emergencies). This number is used for crimes in progress or other situations that require police response, but that are non-life threatening (i.e. loud parties, a group of juveniles loitering in front of your home, neighbor disputes, etc.).

 - **TEXT-A-TIP/ PHONE-A-CRIME TIP-** To provide anonymous tips, text CRIMES (274637) on your cell phone and begin the message with the letters LAPD. You may also submit an anonymous tips anytime, anywhere, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, by phone 800-222-TIPS (800-222-8477). - **TREE REMOVAL REQUIRES BOARD PERMISSION:** Trees help create the neighborhood feel and are protected in our CC&Rs. **Cutting down trees without the HOA board approval is not allowed.** According to our CC&Rs, regardless of whether your tree is sick, dying or the “city told you to cut it down,” you must apply for and obtain approval from the Board prior to cutting down any trees. Landscape applications can be found on the BHA website at <http://www.beverlywoodhoa.com/> under community/forms and documents. You may also call the office and request an application.
- **CONSTRUCTION SITE CLEANLINESS AND WORK HOURS:** Please keep your construction site clean and be aware of debris that might have encroached on your neighbors’ property. **Construction and demolition may only be undertaken during the following time periods: (1) Monday – Friday: 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; (2) Saturday: 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. No work shall take place on Sundays and National Holidays.**
- **STREET WORK ON HILSBORO:** The Department of Public Works is working on roadway improvements on Hillsboro Ave., between Cresta Drive and Robertson. Please be aware of road closures and detours. Thank you for your understanding and patience during this project. The DPW requests that driving be limited within the project area to avoid possible damage to your vehicle. The project is slated to be completed within a week, provided no extenuating circumstances arise.
